#### **Amendment to Project Cost Share**

One time at County boards

Preparatory work is understanding how cost-share and plans could be amended.

Geoff Green has been reviewing the Transit Plans adopted in 2011/12 and discussed possible scenarios:

- Transit Plan updated w/errata
- Full update, which would include changing project delivery dates (example was Hillsborough Train Station)
- Considering which to do after the FTA Risk Assesment Report issued

John wants to discuss what working groups need to be created, especially if the changes are smaller (errata). He talked about how the D-O financial plans for Commuter Rail in 2030 (20% of costs) does not match Wake County Plan.

John proposed that GoTriangle would do a briefing on the Financial Plan, in October, try to do efficiently so that 1 per county, align with SWG meeting.
