**Subject: REQUEST FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA)
APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NUMBER #6 OF THE NORTH CAROLINA
2016-2025 STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP)**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation requests FTA approval to add the following projects to the 2016-2025 STIP. None of the STIP amendments in this letter reflect any change in the distribution of Governor's Apportionment Section 5307 funds.

LEGEND FOR THE TABLES:

DIVISION: This is the North Carolina Highway Division Number in which the project is located. The State is divided into 14 distinct geographic highway divisions.

STIP#: identifying unique number for the project in the STIP

FUND: Type of federal, state, and local fund source used to pay for the project. The federal types include 5307 (FUZ), 5316 (JARC), FNF (5317 New Freedom), Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ), FNU (5311), FEPD (5310 Elderly and Persons with Disabilities), and 5339 (FBUS)

MATCH: Indicates the funding breakdown between federal (US), state (S), and local (L) funds

FY 16-FY 25: This table shows the amount of funding to be programmed for each fiscal year. All funding amounts shown are in thousands (000's)




