


APPENDIX E - CROSS-SECTION GUIDELINES


DCHC MPO policy is to promote the cross-section designs in this appendix to create roadways that are multi-modal and sensitive to the local context (e.g., land use, non-automotive trips). These designs are guidelines. The final cross-section design of a road depends on many operational, planimetric, contour and land use factors, and thus design decision must be made on a case-by-case basis.


TYPICAL ROADWAY CROSS SECTIONS





TYPICAL ROADWAY CROSS SECTIONS FOR ACCOMMODATING BICYCLES
















TYPICAL ROADWAY CROSS SECTIONS

















SIX LANES DIVIDED WITH GRASS MEDIAN - FREEWAY
