RESOLUTION TO MODIFY THE 2020-2029 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE DURHAM-CHAPEL HILL-CARRBORO METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA

AMENDMENT #14 April 12, 2023

A motion was made by MPO Board Member Michael Parker and seconded by MPO Board Member Camille Berry for the adoption of the following resolution, and upon being put to a vote, was duly adopted.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a staged multiple year listing of all federally funded transportation projects scheduled for implementation within the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Area which have been selected from a priority list of projects; and

WHEREAS, the document provides the mechanism for official endorsement of the program of projects by the MPO Board; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of the TIP in the transportation planning process was first mandated by regulations issued jointly by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and no project within the planning area will be approved for funding by these federal agencies unless it appears in the officially adopted TIP; and

WHEREAS, the procedures for developing the TIP have been modified in accordance with certain provisions of the MAP-21 Federal Transportation Act, Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act, and guidance provided by the State; and

WHEREAS, projects listed in the TIP are also included in the State TIP (STIP) and balanced against anticipated revenues as identified in both the TIP and the STIP; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation and the MPO Board have determined it to be in the best interest of the Urban Area to amend the FY 2020-2029 Transportation Improvement Program as described in the attached sheets; and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency Designated the DCHC MPO from nonattainment to attainment under the prior 1997 Ozone Standard on December 26, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the DCHC MPO certifies that this TIP amendment is consistent with the intent of the DCHC MPO 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 23 CFR 450.326 (d), the TIP shall include, to the maximum extent practicable, a description of the anticipated effect of the TIP toward achieving the performance targets identified in the metropolitan transportation plan, linking investment priorities to those performance targets; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization Board hereby approves Amendment #14 to the FY 2020-2029 Transportation Improvement Program of the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Urban Area, as approved by the Board on April 12, 2023, and as described in the "FY 2020-2029 TIP Amendment #14 Summary Sheet" on this, the 12th day of April, 2023.

This memo serves as the official notification regarding the swapping of funding sources for several projects within the DCHC-MPO, as previously agreed to via email. This swap could potentially help NCDOT secure additional federal funding for North Carolina as part of FHWA's annual August Redistribution process.

The funding swap involves switching \$847,000 of DCHC-MPO's Transportation Alternatives Program-Direct Attributable (TAP-DA) federal funds in fiscal year (FY) 2023 for \$847,000 in federal TAP-AnyArea (transportation alternatives funds that can be used in any area in the state). There is no impact to schedules, local matches, or project management requirements resulting from the swap. The TAP-DA funds will be used to fund construction on STIP Project EB-5721, where NCDOT had previously planned to use TAP-AnyArea funds for the STI funded portion of the project.

In return, NCDOT will provide \$847,000 in TAP-AnyArea funds to eligible projects selected by the DCHC-MPO.

Summary

Amendment #14 to the FY2020-29 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) adds \$2.3 million in Community Project Funding and local fund match to the R. Kelly Bryant Bridge Trail. TIP Amendment #14 also adds several projects to the TIP including the N-S-BRT. This amendment also updates the funding for the Chapel Hill portion of the Morgan Creek Greenway.

As there are projects with changes in excess of \$1 million, per the MPO's Public Involvement Plan (PIP), this amendment was released for a 21-day public comment period. The current timeline for adoption is as follows:

- February 22: TC recommended Board release for public comment
- March 8: Board released for public comment
- March 22: TC recommended Board approves amendment
- April 12: Board approves amendment

The original timeline for this amendment was set for approval in May to allow a 21-day public comment period between Board release and TC recommendation. This date was moved back to April so that a 21-day comment period exists only between Board release and Board recommendation.

Several administrative modifications have been made to this amendment post-release for public comment, which mainly consisted of STIP number updates for existing projects. These changes are considered minor per amendment procedures and do not require additional public comment opportunity.

Due to the overlapping time frame of this amendment and adoption of a new STIP, projects with funding in FY24 or later will likely be processed post FY24-33 STIP adoption.

Public comment for this amendment was available March 13 - April 3, 2023.
